A. KATHLEEN TOMLINSON, Magistrate Judge:

The Court has received the letter motion of Defendant Village of Westhampton Beach (“Westhampton Beach”) which (i) requests an additional two weeks to reply to the *amicus* brief submitted by non-party East End Eruv Association (“EEEE”), and (ii) notes that Westhampton Beach has been in touch with “another group” which would like to submit an *amicus* response, and requesting an extension on that group’s behalf. DE 123. Westhampton Beach’s motion is GRANTED in part and DENIED in part.

Given the limited issues raised in EEEA’s *amicus* brief, the time for Westhampton Beach to submit its opposition is extended for one week, to April 22, 2014. Moreover, the Court finds that further briefing from non-parties regarding the questions under review is not needed. Therefore, Westhampton Beach’s request on behalf of an unidentified “another group” is DENIED.
